Forklift Safety | Task executor learnings from incidents

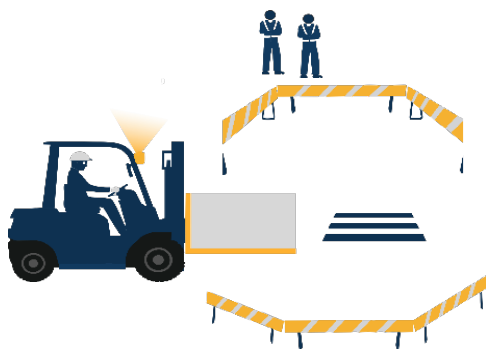


1. Obstructed view:

A flagman should assist when a forklift is being operated in restricted spaces and/or the operator's view is obstructed.

2. Obstructed view:

A forklift operator should drive in reverse if the load being carried obstructs the view.



3. Barricading:

When a flagman is not available, the area/route should be barricaded to prevent pedestrians from entering the area where the forklift is being operated.

4. Visual and audible devices:

Visual and audible devices must be fitted on forklifts. These devices should be inspected prior to use and maintained accordingly.



Safe forklift operations keep pedestrians and forklift operators safe.
